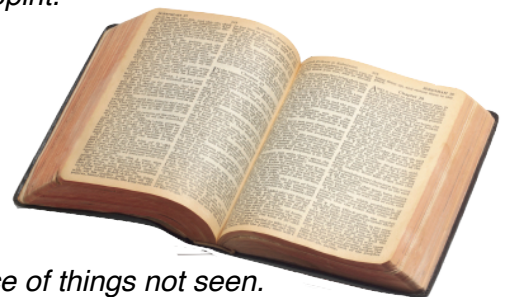
Great Claims Require Great Evidence

The Heart of Revelation

The book of Revelation is basically divided into two halves: the first deals with the history of the church from the time of John until today, while the second half deals with events leading up to and even beyond the return of Jesus. But in the heart of Revelation we find the fascinating background to the whole problem of evil.

Revelation 12:7-9 *And war broke out in heaven: Michael and his angels fought with the dragon; and the dragon and his angels fought, but they did not prevail, nor was place found for them in heaven any longer. So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.*

"An Enemy Has Done This"

Matthew 13:24-30 *"The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field; but while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat and went his way. But when the grain had sprouted and produced a crop, then the tares also appeared. So the servants of the owner came and said to him, 'Sir, did you not sow good seed in your field? How then does it have tares?' He said to them, 'An enemy has done this.' The servants said to him, 'Do you want us then to go and gather them up?' But he said, 'No, lest while you gather up the tares you also uproot the wheat with them. Let both grow together until the harvest, and at the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, "First gather together the tares and bind them in bundles to burn them, but gather the wheat into my barn."'*

Problem #1: Your Past

Matthew 24:26, 27 "Therefore if they say to you, 'Look, He is in the desert!' do not go out; or 'Look, He is in the inner rooms!' do not believe it. For as the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.

Acts 1:9-11 Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel, who also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven."

1 Thessalonians 4:16, 17 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.

A New Body, But NOT A New Character

1 Corinthians 15:51, 52 Behold, I tell you a mystery: we shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed-- in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead in Christ shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. (see **Romans 8:23**; **Philippians 3:20, 21**)

Matthew 7:21-23 "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!'" (see **1 John 3:4-6**)

Matthew 25:44-46 "Then they also will answer Him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to You?' Then He will answer them, saying, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to Me.' And these will go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

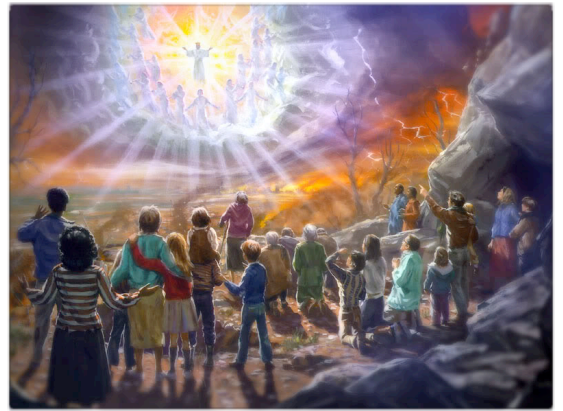

Death Is Like Sleep

Then Jesus said to them plainly, “Lazarus is dead.”

How Deep Is The Sleep Of Death?

Ecclesiastes 9:5,6 For the living know that they will die; But the dead know nothing, and they have no more reward, for the memory of them is forgotten. Also their love, their hatred, and their envy have now perished; Nevermore will they have a share in anything done under the sun.

Psalms 146:3,4 Do not put your trust in princes, nor in a son of man, in whom there is no help. His spirit departs, he returns to his earth; In that very day his plans perish.

Psalms 115:17 The dead do not praise the Lord, nor any who go down into silence.

Two Different Deaths

Revelation 20:1-6 Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years ... This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power.

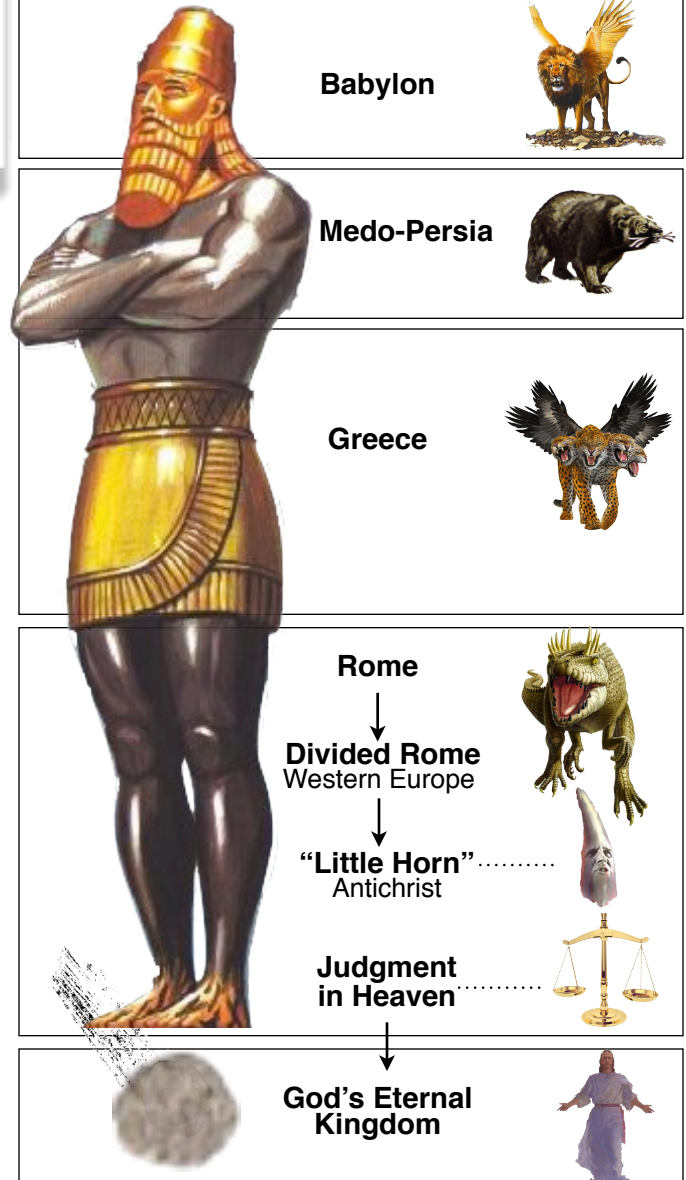

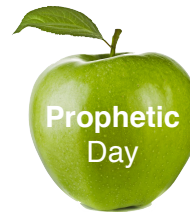

- ✓ Daniel is “greatly troubled.”

Daniel 8

- ✓ The focus is once again on the “little horn” and his blasphemous, violent activities.
- ✓ Daniel is told the judgment in heaven will begin at the end of 2300 years.
- ✓ No starting point for the 2300 years given and the vision stalls; no mention of Christ’s Kingdom!

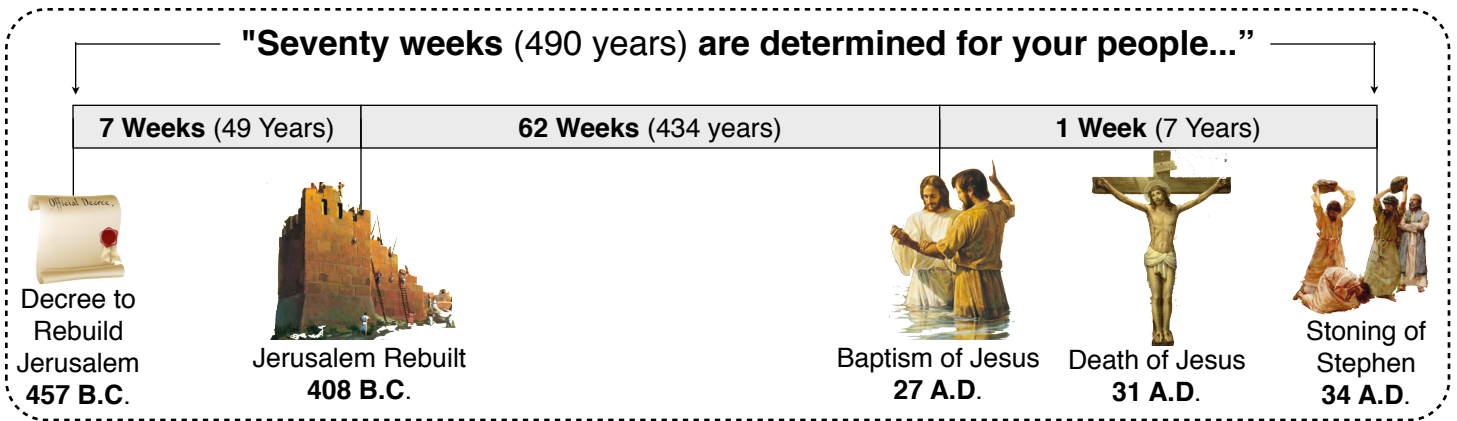

And I, Daniel, fainted and was sick for days; afterward I arose and went about the king's business. I was astonished by the vision [mareh], but no one understood it."

Daniel 9:21-23 "While I was speaking in prayer, the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision [hazon] at the beginning, being caused to fly swiftly, reached me about the time of the evening offering. And he informed me, and talked with me, and said, "O Daniel, I have now come forth to give you skill to understand. 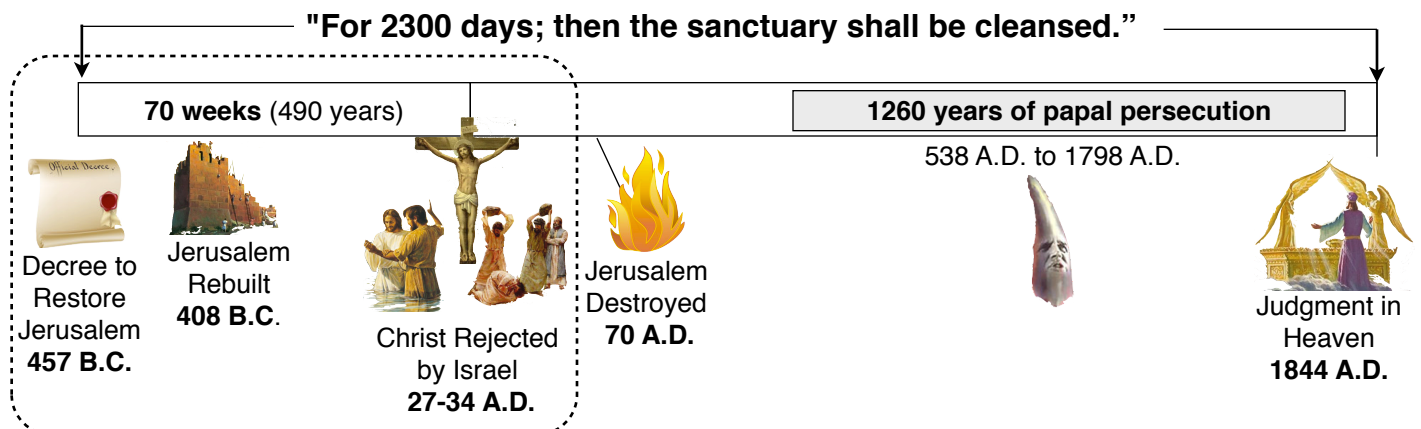

The Mark Of The Beast Is Also A Counterfeit

Revelation 7:2, 3 Then I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God. And he cried with a loud voice to the four angels to whom it was granted to harm the earth and the sea, saying, "Do not harm the earth, the sea, or the trees till we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads."

Revelation 13:12-17 he exercises all the authority of the first beast in his presence, and causes the earth and those who dwell in it to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed. He performs great signs, so that he even makes fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men. And he deceives those who dwell on the earth by those signs which he was granted to do in the sight of the beast, telling those who dwell on the earth to make an image to the beast who was wounded by the sword and lived. He was granted power to give breath to the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak and cause as many as would not worship the image of the beast to be killed. He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hand or on their foreheads, and that no one may buy or sell except one who has the mark or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man: His number is 666.

3. The Redeemed Demonstrate Loyalty to God

Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

4. The Devil’s “Short Time” Before Being Destroyed

Revelation 12:12 Therefore rejoice, O heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time.”



Why Doesn’t Satan Die When Christ Returns?

Revelation 19:11-21 Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.

Revelation 20:1-3 Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, having the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; and he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should deceive the nations no more till the thousand years were finished. But after these things he must be released for a little while.

The Saints Will Judge The World

Revelation 20:4-6 *And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years.*

- ✓ **1 Corinthians 6:2, 3** *“Do you not know that the saints will judge the world?...Do you not know that we shall judge angels? (see **Jude 6**; **Matthew 8:28, 29**; **2 Peter 2:9**)*
- ✓ Obviously these saints are not deciding who should be saved or lost; that was determined by Christ during the investigative judgment before His return. The saints are now reviewing Christ’s judgments, ratifying them with their approval, and—in union with Christ—apportioning the sentence of “each one according to his works.”
- ✓ **Psalms 149** *Praise the Lord! Sing to the Lord a new song, and His praise in the assembly of saints... For the Lord takes pleasure in His people; He will beautify the humble with salvation. Let the saints be joyful in glory; Let them sing aloud on their beds. Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand, to execute vengeance on the nations, and punishments on the peoples; to bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron; to execute on them the written judgment-- this honor have all His saints. Praise the Lord!*

Revelation 20:7-8, 12-13 *Now when the thousand years have expired, Satan will be released from his prison and will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth... And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books. The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works.*

Every Knee Shall Bow

#1: Hell Only Lasts Forever

Revelation 14:9-11 “If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives his mark on his forehead or on his hand ...shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb. And the smoke of their torment ascends forever and ever; and they have no rest day or night, who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name.”

Revelation 20:9, 10 They went up on the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city. And fire came down from God out of heaven and devoured them. The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

Those verses are not very encouraging if we apply our common understanding of “forever” as being time without end. But is that what “forever” means in Scripture?

Exodus 21:5, 6 But if the servant plainly says, ‘I love my master, my wife, and my children; I will not go out free,’ then his master shall bring him to the judges. He shall also bring him to the door, or to the doorpost, and his master shall pierce his ear with an awl; and he shall serve him forever.

1 Samuel 1:22 Now the man Elkanah and all his house went up to offer to the Lord the yearly sacrifice and his vow. But Hannah did not go up, for she said to her husband, “Not until the child is weaned; then I will take him, that he may appear before the Lord and remain there forever.”



King David and “Forever”

1 Samuel 28:2 ... “Therefore I will make you one of my chief guardians forever.”

Psalms 89:1 “I will sing of the mercies of the Lord forever”

Psalms 145:1, 2 I will extol You, my God, O King; And I will bless Your name forever and ever. Every day I will bless You, and I will praise Your name forever and ever.

Revelation 22:4, 5 They shall see His face, and His name shall be on their foreheads. There shall be no night there: They need no lamp nor light of the sun, for the Lord God give them light. And they shall reign forever and ever. (see also **1 Timothy 6:16** and **Exodus 33:18-20**)

Isaiah 33:14, 15 “Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? Who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings?” He who walks righteously and speaks uprightly.”



#5: Hell Isn't Meant For You!

Matthew 25:34, 41 While the righteous “inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world,” only the wicked are sent “into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels.”

The Persecuting Church

The woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet, and adorned with gold and precious stones and pearls, having in her hand a golden cup full of abominations and the filthiness of her fornication. And on her forehead a name was written: MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND OF THE ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH. I saw the woman, drunk with the blood of the saints and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus. And when I saw her, I marveled with great amazement.



The Persecuted Church

- ✓ The woman of Revelation 12 represents God's true people, especially those persecuted by the papacy.

Revelation 12:1, 2 ...a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a garland of twelve stars. Then being with child, she cried out in labor and in pain to give birth. (see **Genesis 37:1-11**; **Galatians 4:4**)

Revelation 12:3, 4 And another sign appeared in heaven: behold, a great, fiery red dragon having seven heads and ten horns, and seven diadems on his heads... And the dragon stood before the woman who was ready to give birth, to devour her Child as soon as it was born. (see **Matthew 2:16**)



Revelation 12:5, 6 She bore a male Child who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron. And her Child was caught up to God and His throne. Then the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, that they should feed her there one thousand two hundred and sixty days. (see **Acts 1:9-11**; **Daniel 7:25**)

Revelation 12:17 And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring, who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

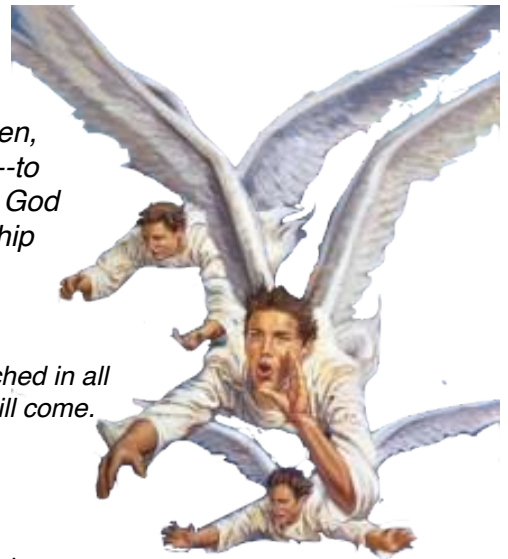

 - Not a new gospel, but the *everlasting* gospel
 - **Matthew 24:14** And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.
- ✓ The gospel is preached in the time of the judgment.
 - All the rest of Scripture speaks of the judgment in the future
 - At this point, however, the judgment has begun.
- ✓ The evidence of genuine conversion is obedience to God's commandments
 - The seal of God is true worship on the seventh-day Sabbath as instructed in the Ten Commandments
 - Revelation 14:7 contains Revelation's longest Old Testament quotation... and it comes straight from the Fourth Commandment!



THE SECOND ANGEL'S MESSAGE

Revelation 14:8 And another angel followed, saying, "Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she has made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication."

- ✓ With the antichrist temporarily "wounded" and the judgment finally underway, pure truth from God's word is proclaimed boldly to those within the Roman Catholic Church and her apostate Protestant "daughters."

Here is the patience of the saints; here are those who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus."

- ✓ The message is simple and to the point... "Don't worship the beast!" At this point everyone on the earth will demonstrate their allegiance either to Christ or to Satan.
- ✓ **Revelation 22:11, 12** He who is unjust, let him be unjust still; he who is filthy, let him be filthy still; he who is righteous, let him be righteous still; he who is holy, let him be holy still. And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work."
- ✓ **Revelation 14:14, 15** Then I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and on the cloud sat One like the Son of Man, having on His head a golden crown, and in His hand a sharp sickle. And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to Him who sat on the cloud, "Thrust in Your sickle and reap, for the time has come for You to reap, for the harvest of the earth is ripe." (see **Matthew 13:38-43**)
